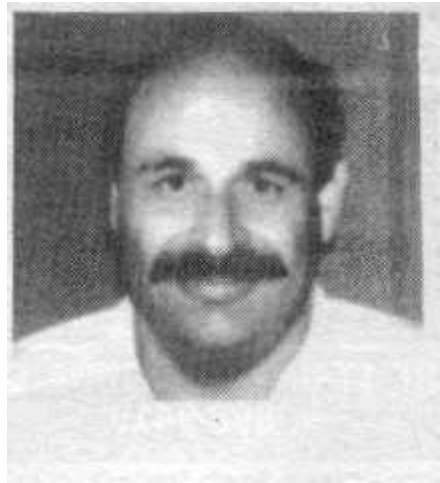
**Cash Rewards Of Up To \$1,000**

## HOMICIDE

On Thursday, October 10, 1991, at approximately 1:15 p.m., a postal worker found Samuel Baruch, 34, lying on the floor by a safe in Mr. Baruch's office, located in the 300 block of Birchwood Park Drive.

Mr. Baruch died as a result of gunshot wounds to the head. His 1987 silver Mercury Marquis was missing but later recovered on Sunday, October 13 in the south side parking lot of Pembroke Mall.

The apparent motive for the murder was robbery.
