# UNSOLVED CRIME

**Cash Rewards Of Up To \$1,000**

## HOMICIDE

On Tuesday, October 26, 2010, at approximately 7:14 a.m., Virginia Beach Police and Emergency Services Personnel responded to the 400 block of Oceana Blvd. for a man located on the side of the road. A driver heading northbound on Oceana Blvd. noticed a Ford F-150 parked on the side of the road and stopped to render assistance. He discovered the male and called 911. Officers arrived on scene and found the man suffering from a gunshot wound(s) and he was pronounced dead at the scene.

The victim has been identified as **Victor Edward Decker**, 25, of Virginia Beach. Officer Decker has been identified as a current member of the Norfolk Police Department. He was off-duty at the time of this incident.

The Detective Bureau continues to thoroughly investigate this homicide. We have been able to confirm that our victim was at a breast cancer awareness event in the Atlantis Gentleman's Club on **Monday night, October 25, 2010**. Detectives are seeking to speak with **every** person that was at the Atlantis Gentleman's Club **anytime** on Monday night or early Tuesday morning.
